



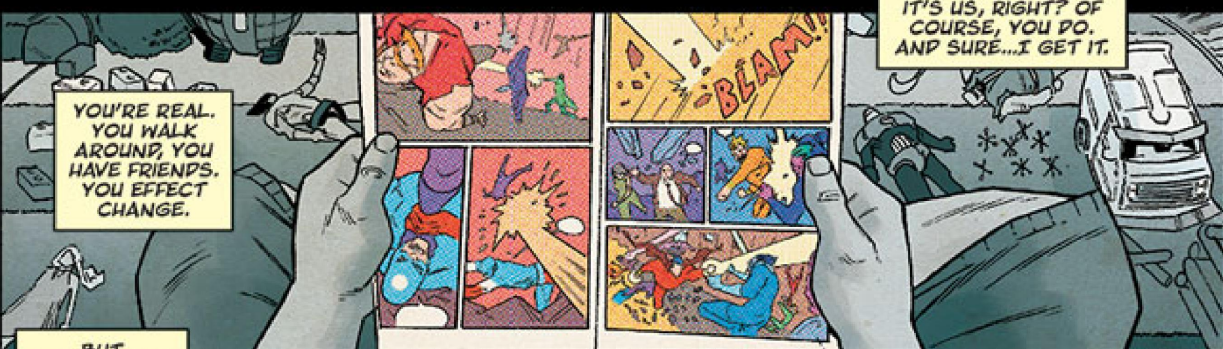

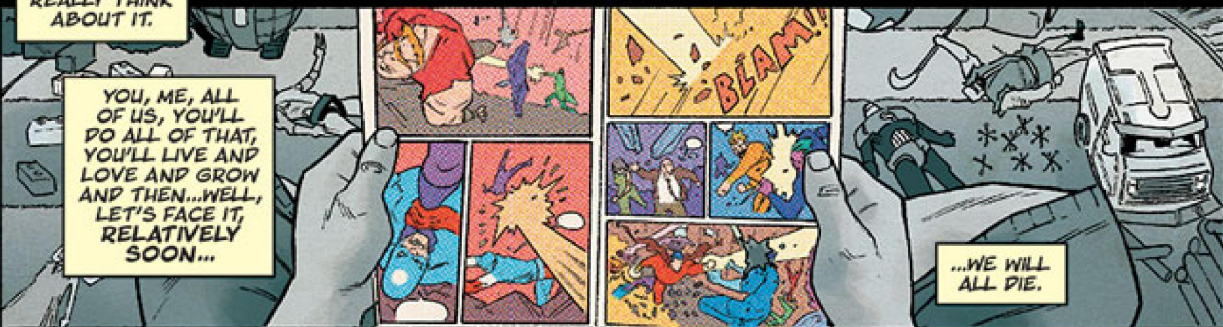


OR SUPERMAN?
