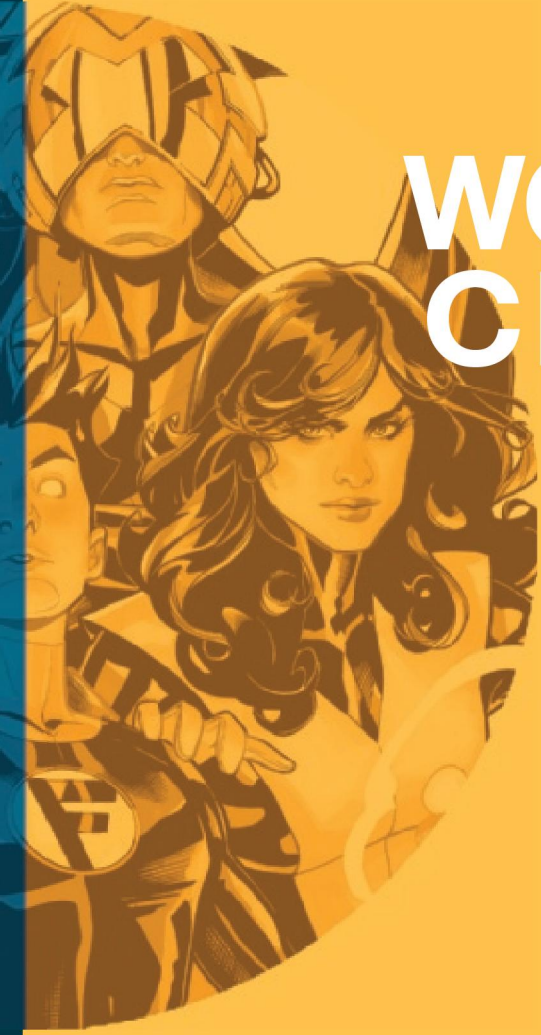

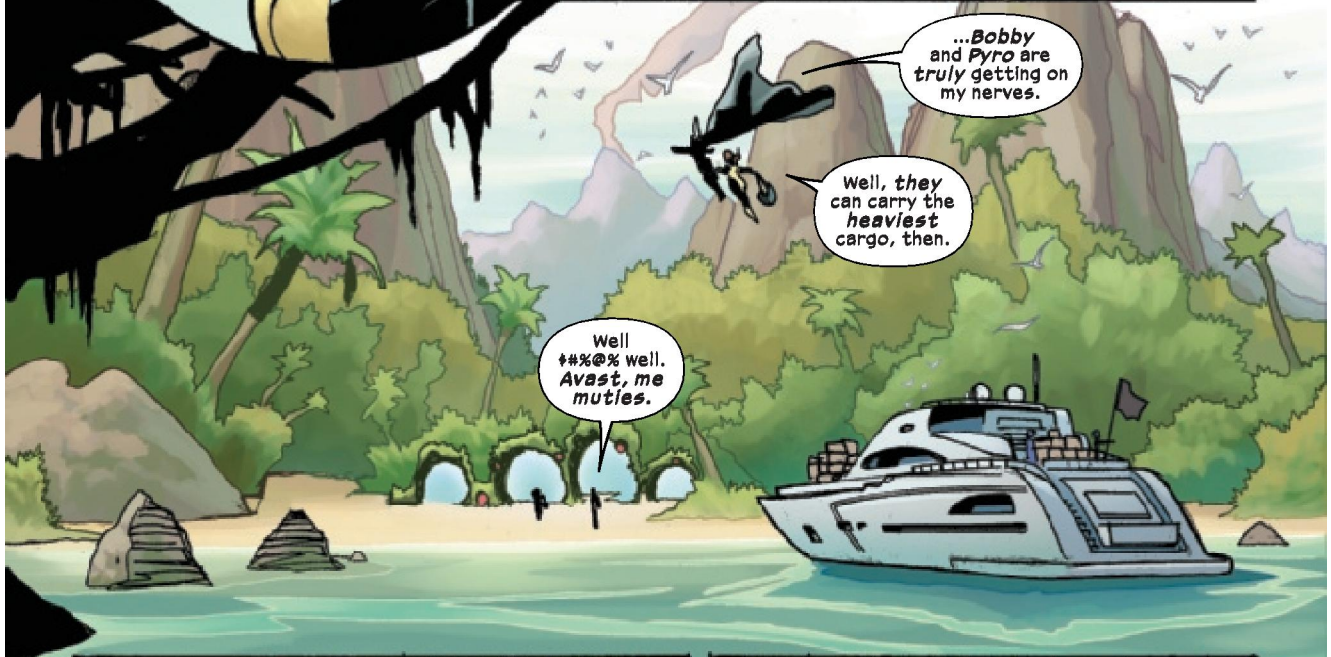
THE PACIFIC OCEAN.
